

Welcome to the final Deputy's Corner report for Term 2. This term has simply flown by!

Traffic News Update

There has been a notable increase in the number of drivers entering Bethany via the 'exit' gate (the Bethany end drive way). This is happening frequently during the day, especially on Wednesdays when parents are coming in for Chapel. Please be mindful that using this 'exit' as an entrance is extremely dangerous. The only time the 'exit' is used as an entrance is after hours when the Temple driveway gate is locked.

Many parents and local residents are also getting extremely frustrated by drivers who park along Countess Street in clearly marked, "No Parking" areas. This makes it very hard to navigate in the height of before school and after school traffic. Salisbury Council and SAPOL have assured us that traffic inspectors make regular checks to monitor the school traffic. If you are concerned about a driver's conduct on the roads, please call the Salisbury Council (8406 8222) or SAPOL (131 444) to lodge a complaint. At no point should you attempt to video the driver or confront them if you feel they are in breach of a road rule or etiquette. Simply record the details you are able to (such as vehicle model, colour, make, registration number plate and driver's appearance) and make a report to either SAPOL or the council.

Please be aware that beyond the school fence line, Bethany Christian School has no legal jurisdiction on the road or the road laws.



Uniform Reminder

It is getting very cold and students need to dress warmly to ensure that they do not become unwell. Please check that your child's name is clearly marked on all jackets and jumpers. Students are also coming to school wearing beanies, gloves and scarfs etc. Please ensure that the colours of these garments complement our school uniform. Red, black and white can be worn with the PE uniform, blue, grey and white can be worn with the everyday blue uniform. Girls are increasingly being found to be wearing hair ties, scrunchies and headbands in colours that are not school regulation. Please leave the hot pink, orange, purple, green hair ties, scrunchies, headbands and so on for home use.

Hats are another item that are regularly either lost or forgotten. Please also ensure that your child's name is clearly written in their hats. Remember, hats are an item that are worn all year around. Please encourage your child to be super organised and remember to pack their hat when they go to school.


