
# OUR LEARNING



We are learning about the sounds Nn and Ff in Jolly Phonics. The name of the letter is pronounced enn, eff and the sound that it makes is /n/ as in 'nut' and 'name' and /f/ as in 'fish' and 'four'. **Can you find things that start**
