OUR LEARNING



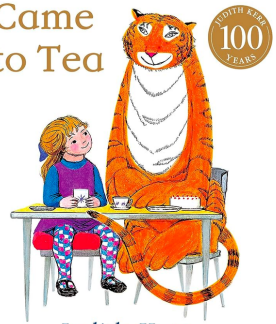
We are learning about the fruits of the Spirit this term. This week we are learning about **GOODNESS!**

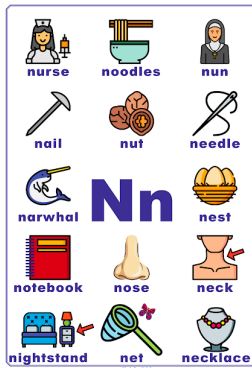


We are continuing to "Eat the Rainbow" this week!

OUR LEARNING

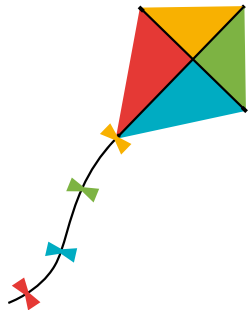
Our ELC play kitchen is becoming a cafe & shop! Using play money, we will learn about paying for items.
