Reading with your child provides opportunities for you to strengthen connection and supports children to regulate and wind down. Reading with your child promotes crucial oral language development. Children need to hear language before they use language.

Book reading is a powerful part of supporting children to develop their literacy skills. One way you can deepen the learning at home is to talk about the books you are reading. Try hooking them in with questions like, "I wonder what will happen if...". You could explore the characters emotions together, "How is ... feeling right now? Why's that?". You could even empower your child to read the pictures "Have a look at the picture, what do you think is happening in the story?". There are endless ways to promote oral language through reading with your child. Have fun reading together!

Here at the ELC, we are kind to one another! This week we will reflect on our friendships here. Can you tell someone in your family who your friends at the ELC are?






Together we will be planting autumn vegetables this week! What vegetable are you most excited to see growing in our garden?
