Is there something you learnt during NAIDOC Week that you can share with your family?



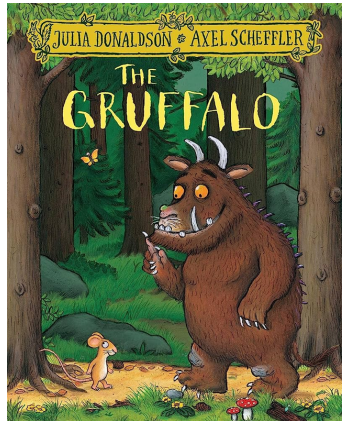
We are meeting Bug this week who will help to teach us the scared and brave feeling!
