OUR LEARNING

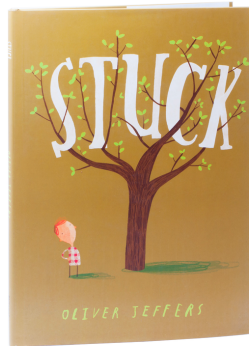


We are learning about the fruits of the Spirit this term. This week we are learning about **KINDNESS!**

Is there a new fruit or vegetable that you would like to eat again after trying it this week?

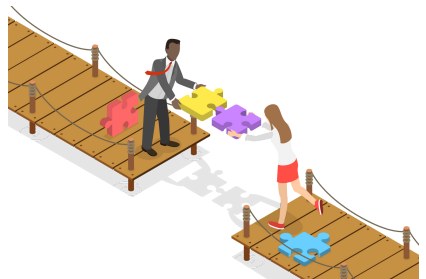


This week, we are practicing our estimating and counting skills in the garden together.
