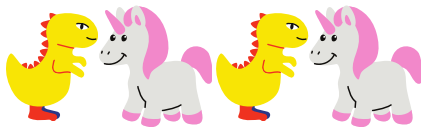
Action: Pretend to eat

We are learning about the letters 'Yy' and 'Xx'. The names of the letters are 'we' and 'ex', and the sounds they make are /y/ as in yo-yo and /ks/ as in box.

What are some other words that start with Y and X? Is there anything in your house that starts with these letters?

We are learning about blending and segmenting the sounds in words, and matching words with the same beginning sounds.

Can you sound out these sounds? C-a-t? M-a-t? Now can you put them all together and say the words?



We will be learning more about patterns this fortnight!

Can you make an ABAB pattern with some of your toys at home? Now can you try making an ABCABC pattern?

OUR LEARNING

We are learning new things through books during our Storybook Challenge! Every afternoon we will be reading a new storybook to promote literacy and comprehension skills, and exercise our imaginations.

Can you try sounding out some of the sounds in your book? Can you try blending the sounds together to make a word?



We are learning about flexible and stuck thinking, and that problems come in different sizes, so our responses should too.

What can you do when your thoughts get stuck?

What kind of response should you have to a small problem?

We will be exploring "We Challenge" this term with different challenges! This week we will do the Father's Day Challenge.

What did you cook or make for your dad for the Father's Day Challenge? Did you have fun?

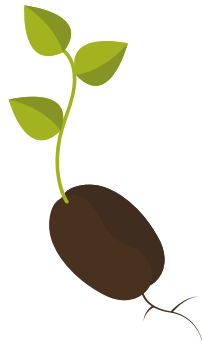


OTHER INFORMATION
